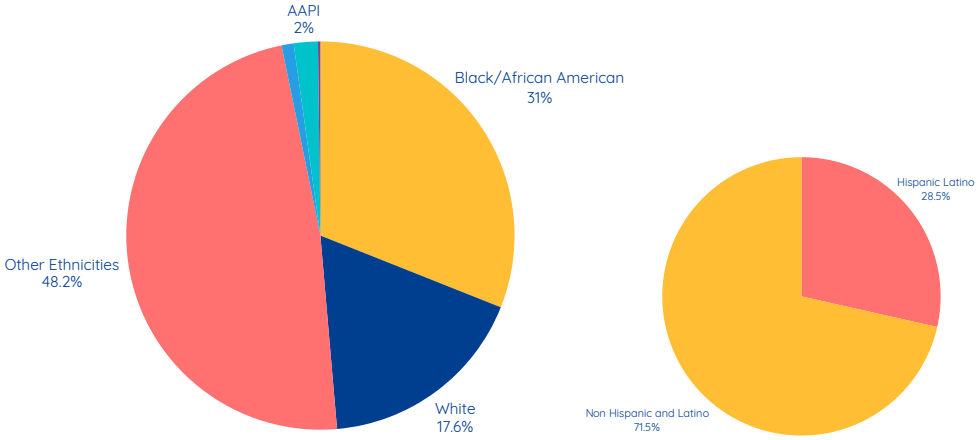

## PATIENT DEMOGRAPHIC DATA

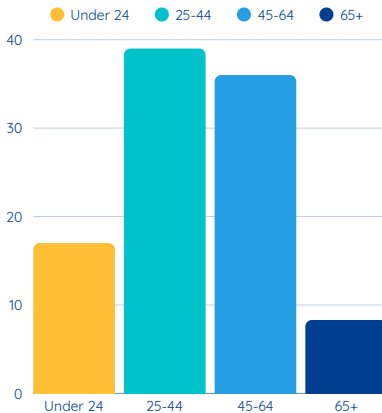


**31%** of our patient population is Black or African American and nearly **30%** of our patient population is Hispanic or Latino.

Nearly **75%** of our patient population are between the ages of **25** and **64**.

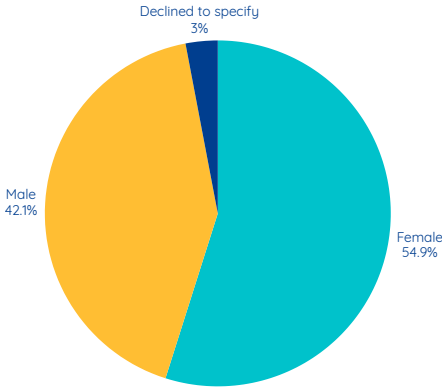
An estimated **17%** of our patient population is under 24 years old.

**54.9%** of Gennesaret's patients were women in 2025.

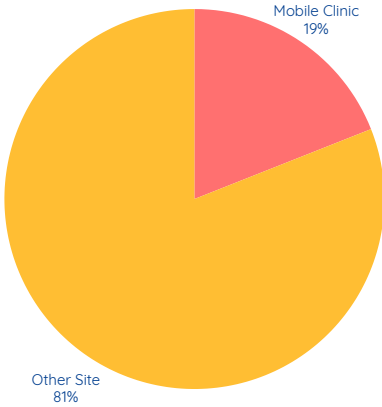

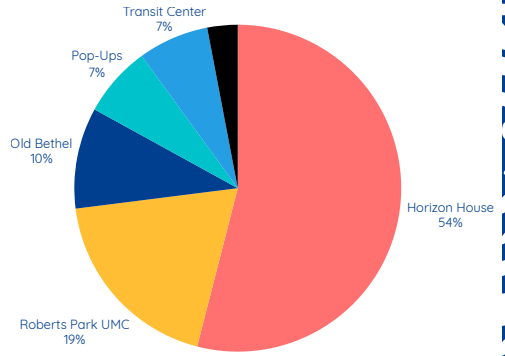
Our **cost-free** and **insurance-free** services are available to people of all demographics and ages. We meet people where they are at in life.

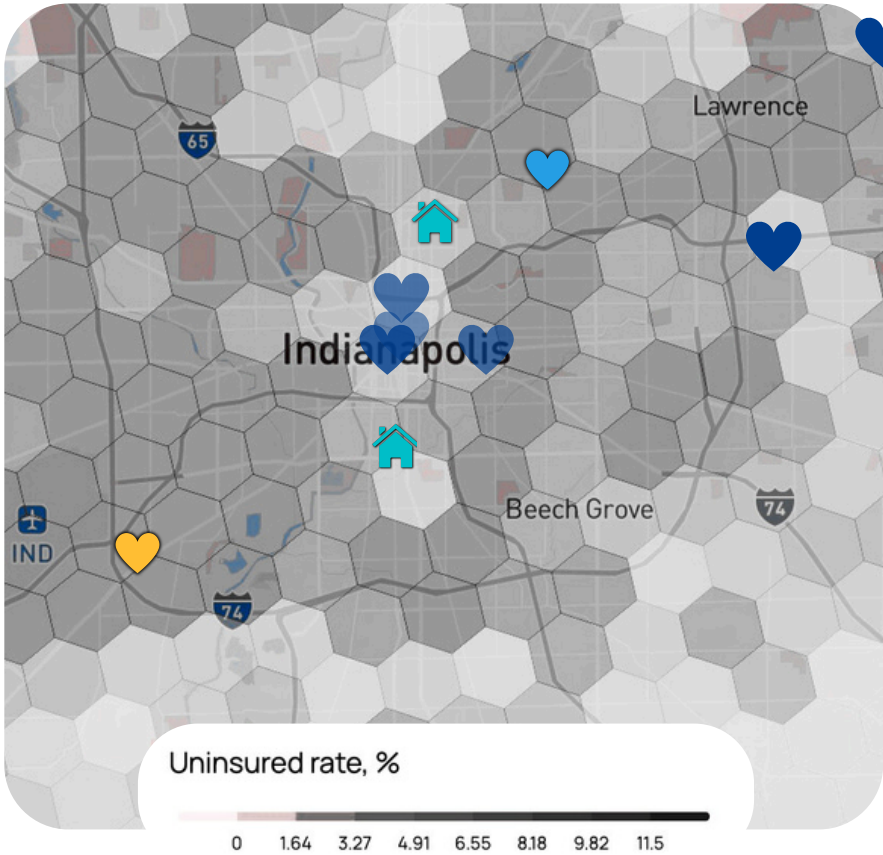
**Patient impact increased by 17% with new mobile clinic sites added in FY2025, Recovery Cafe and Carriage House East Success Center.**

We have 3 health recovery homes that can serve up to  
16 residents at a time, 12 men and 4 women.

We clothe them, house them, feed them, provide  
medical respite care, and moreover,

They fed me...I had clean clothing, new everything...a  
bed to sleep in...It was remarkable what they had  
done for me...**It was like a stepping stone for  
everything I needed to do for myself...and that's  
basically how they saved my life...**"



# WHERE WE MAKE OUR IMPACT

## MEDICAL CLINICS



- Primary and preventative care
- Personalized care for chronic diseases such as diabetes and hypertension with advanced medication formulary
- Free Prescription Medications
- Onsite rapid lab testing for routine test, general health screening, and chronic conditions
- Specialized hypertension management program in partnership with Purdue University Center for Equity Health Inclusion
- Onsite pharmacy
- STI testing and treatment
- Extensive referral program



## DENTAL CLINIC

- Preventative care
- Examinations and cleanings
- Restorative work and extractions
- X-Rays
- Denture program, providing full and partial dentures
- Extensive referral program for specialized services



## MOBILE MEDICAL CLINIC

- Urgent care right on the streets
- Focuses on patients living in shelters, vehicles or homeless encampments
- Mobile pharmacy
- Focus on chronic disease
- Extensive referral program for specialized services
- Equipped with an onboard restroom, phlebotomy chair, wheelchair lift

## WOMEN'S HEALTH SERVICES

- Focus on early detection screening for breast and cervical cancer
- Enhanced focus on women of color, who face higher risks of negative cancer outcomes
- Free patient navigation and diagnostic services for abnormal screening results
- Bilingual Clinic Manager supporting our Spanish-speaking patients

## HEALTH RECOVERY HOMES

- Residential homes that foster recovery, dignity, and respect
- Individualized mental health treatment plan within 72 hours
- Medical case management with onsite Registered Nurse
- Social work case management with onsite Case Manager
- Permanent housing support
- Emphasis on veterans experiencing homelessness and their return to self-sufficiency with Helping Veterans and Families (HVAF)

# A GLIMPSE AT GENNESARET'S INVESTMENT

in FY25

## \$42,570

spent on prescription medications this year—ensuring that every patient who walked through our doors received the care they needed, completely free of charge

## \$66,300

spent on external referrals for Women's Health Services patients. These funds made it possible for women with abnormal test results to receive additional screenings and critical treatments for breast and cervical cancer at no cost

## \$19,981

spent on dentures, restoring not only the patients' smiles but also their confidence, dignity, and ability to eat and speak comfortably

## \$2,108,729

total operating cost, enabling us to provide free comprehensive care across all of our service lines. From life-saving medical clinics and vital dental care to specialized Women's Health Services and our Health Recovery Home, every dollar was spent ensuring that our patients receive the treatment and support they need.

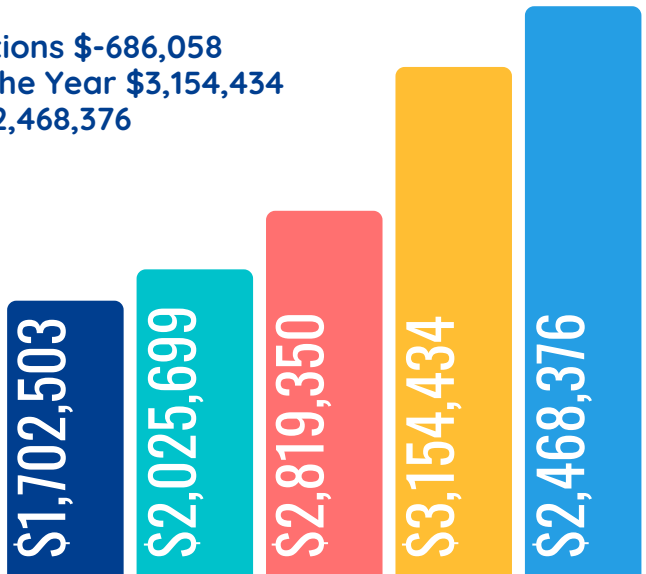
